▶ How it works

- Personal Support Workers provide personal care, homemaking and emergency response 24 hours a day to seniors living in designated areas
- Residents of Assisted Living locations maintain a sense of community with the people in their building
- Staff are on-site 24 hours a day, 7 days a week

▶ Who can use this service?

- Any senior or adult with a physical disability living in our designated buildings

▶ How this Service is provided

- After an assessment interview, the client is given a schedule of visits by Personal Support Workers, subject to client needs and staff/funding availability.
